# Analyzing Your PSAT Score Report Thurgood Marshall Academy Public Charter School, Washington, DC

Topic: Using Student Achievement Data to Support Instructional Decision Making Practice: Student Use of Data

Teachers at Thurgood Marshall Academy Public Charter School work directly and regularly with students to explain the expectations and objectives of assessments and to help students interpret their results. Staff use the *Analyzing Your PSAT Score Report* tool to help students learn how to analyze and interpret their Preliminary SAT (PSAT) test scores.

Each student completes this tool by analyzing their own PSAT data, comparing it to national scores, and identifying areas of improvement in each content area. This tool varies by grade level. In ninth grade, students are asked to reflect on their prior knowledge of the PSAT. The tool for tenth and eleventh graders does not include this reflection.

Teachers can modify this tool to help students understand, analyze, and reflect on their PSAT or other assessment results.
