Thurgood Marshall Academy Public Charter School administers benchmark assessments on a six- to eight-week cycle. Within a week of each assessment, administrators and teachers meet during Data Afternoons to collaboratively analyze the data and brainstorm strategies for improving instruction. After the Data Afternoons, teachers use the *Classroom Instructional Plan* to document changes and describe their instructional plan for the next benchmark period.

Teachers document the following information in the instructional plan:

- The percentage of students scoring at or above proficiency in reading and math on the District of Columbia Comprehensive Assessment System (DC CAS)
- 2. Total percentage and the number of students scoring below proficiency in each class
- 3. Standards that students in each class have mastered
- 4. Standards that students in each class have not mastered



- 5. Identification of areas for reteaching
- 6. Strategies for reteaching

Teachers can use this plan to develop a similar instructional planning template.
