Parent and Family Survey

Topic: Increased Learning Time: Beyond the Regular School Day

Practice: Evaluate Program

John Muir Elementary School uses this one-page Parent and Family Survey to assess parents' perception of the benefits and effects of the Powerful Schools after-school program and their reasons for enrolling their children. This survey is administered annually to family of students enrolled in the program. Survey questions address program impact on students' academic and social skills. The survey is kept to one page to encourage a high response rate.

The after-school director and the executive director of Powerful Schools analyze the survey data and look for gaps between program goals and survey results. The analysis typically includes descriptive statistics (e.g., means) by survey item. Survey results are used to make improvements or adjustments to the program.

Schools, districts, and program providers can modify the *Parent and Family Survey* to meet their specific needs when collecting data on parent satisfaction with extended learning time programs.
