A student behavior contract is a mutual agreement with a student who needs more supervision or guidance to help positively manage behavior. The contract is developed by the student with help from his/her teacher, and it gives the student prompting questions. The questions included on the student behavior contract are:

- 1. Positive qualities I have that could help make me a good leader.
- 2. Behaviors that prevent me from being a respected leader.
- 3. What do I need to improve my behavior?
- 4. What support do I need?

The contract is then signed by the student and teacher once an agreement is reached. The student is under contract to monitor his/her personal behavior and the teacher or staff member is under contract to support that student and encourage their success. Teachers can use this sample contract to design one that meets the needs of their students. This tool is most recommended for students in the upper elementary grade levels.
